MOA APPOINTMENT SLAS FOR MIGRATION COA

- The MHHS migration design includes requirements specific to Service Level Agreements (SLAs) for MOA Appointments as part of a migration.
- Programme Change request CR-037 updated those requirements

 - Update to recognise that appointments received prior to 17:00 hours should be updated by 23:00

REMOVAL OF LOSING SUPPLIER REFERENCES FOR NEW CONNECTIONS

- The Schedule XX – MHHS Migration code drafting, approved under R0209, includes references to the Losing Supplier in clauses regarding New Connections/Initial Registrations
 - As there is no Losing Supplier for a New Connection and a subsequent Initial Registration, it is not appropriate for the Losing Supplier to be included in the process.
- The clauses impacted are:
 - 3.4 Where a MHHS Reverse Migration occurs, the transmission on an IF-003 Market Message (Notification of Reverse Migration and De-appointment) from the Supplier Meter Registration Service to the Losing Meter Operator Agent (and Advanced / Smart Data Service Agent) will indicate that MHHS Reverse Migration has occurred and the Metering Point is now operating under legacy arrangements. For MHHS Reverse Migration, the IF-003 (Notification of Reverse Migration and De-appointment) will be issued instead of the IF037 Notification of Supplier Agent Appointment. In the case of Initial Registration there is no Losing Meter Operator Agent (or Advanced / Smart Data Service) and therefore the IF-003 (Notification of Reverse Migration and De-appointment) will only be issued to the Losing Supplier, Electricity Enquiry Service and DNO.
