Key Discussion Items	<p>Constituency Rep Mobilisation – The majority of discussion focussed on responses from PSG Constituency Reps to action PSG02-03 (copied above). Constituency Reps were asked to share feedback on the mobilisation of their constituency members. Reps for Elexon, DCC, Supplier Agent, DNO, iDNO and National Grid ESO confirmed their constituency members were mobilised or mobilising. Reps for Large and Medium Suppliers asked for additional time to provide a response to the action. All suppliers raised challenges such as critical issues in the supply market and resource commitments to Faster Switching being reasons for a possible delay. Following discussion, it was agreed these reps would engage with the Programme SRO (action PSG03-02) and provide a response to action PSG02-03 ahead of the February PSG for further discussion.</p>				
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
