





CMP430 Update

Legal Text Update

- Final Legal Text agreed by Workgroup on Friday 5th July for introduction of text to CUSC to support the implementation of the MHHS Programme
- Minor amendments to clauses contained in 14.17.40
- Full review of Section 14 undertaken by Workgroup and also ESO in conjunction with ESO Revenue and ESO Legal:
 - No further legal text changes to be made within the scope of CMP430
 - Clauses identified that could be changed at the end of the MHHS Migration period or superseded by Modification proposals driven by TNUoS TF
 - Workgroup agreed this was the best solution.

Workgroup Vote

• Workgroup vote held on 11th July, where Workgroup voted unanimously that Original (CMP430) is better than Baseline (Current version of CUSC)

Next Steps

- Workgroup Report to be issued to CUSC Panel on 18th August will also be posted on CUSC Website (Go to Workgroup Report section)
- CUSC Panel on 26th August to present Mod and confirm Terms of Reference have been met and CMP430 can go to Code Administration Consultation (CAC)

- Final Modification Report to be submitted to Ofgem on 23rd August, ahead of deadline of 31st August

Important Milestone and relevance for industry

Important to stress to industry that we as a Workgroup have not eliminated the risk of double charging of MPANs during the Transition phase of the MHHS
Programme completely



CMP431 Update

Legal Text Update

- As part of a full Non-Charging CUSC review, it was determined that:
- No amendments were required to Section 3 as a result of the legal text being introduced in CMP430
- Only 1 possible term "BSCCo" could be introduced to Section 11, but Workgroup felt this was already defined in the legal text of CMP430 and question appropriateness of including as part of CMP431.
- Workgroup recommended Withdrawal of CMP431 based on above
- The Proposers withdrew their interest in CMP431 on 11th August and industry notified.

Next Steps

- With industry up to 5pm on 18th July for an industry party to adopt CMP431
- If no part adopts, CMP431 will be formally withdrawn at CUSC Panel on 26th July

MHHS Programme – Ofgem M7 Delivery Summary

Overall Status

- M7 is at risk because the Plan currently makes no provision for Ofgem
 - to assess Final Modification Report (FMR) submissions, including considering Panel recommendations and stakeholders' consultation responses
 - to obtain internal approval and make Ofgem decisions/directions

Month Summary

- Ofgem has raised CR52 which proposes to
 - move the M7 milestone to 11 December
 - clarify that the milestone refers to Ofgem's decisions on the legal text baselined at M6
- Ofgem has begun its review of the BSC, REC and DCUSA legal text and intends to complete this process by mid-August
- · First drafts of the Modification Proposal Forms have been produced
- Ofgem is analysing responses to the Programme Participant Information Request on costs. The analysis will inform Ofgem's view of the impact of the legal text baselined at M6 and will be reflected in the BSC, REC and DCUSA Modification Proposal Forms
- Ofgem and the code bodies have discussed and informally agreed a timetable for consulting on the modification proposals baselined at the August CCAG (see separate slide). Note that the actual timelines will be confirmed and directed by the Authority after the August CCAG

- Ofgem will continue to review the legal text and refine the Modification Proposal forms



Background and update

Background

- Guidance Notes (GNs) and Simple Guides (SGs) are not part of legal baseline and not under formal industry change control
- Elexon are aiming to update GNs and SGs for M8 (7 March 2025)
- Elexon have 188 GNs and 29 SGs

Update

- We have conducted an initial internal review of the 188 GNs
- 89 have been identified as impacted by MHHS and will require updating
- 25 have been identified as not MHHS impacted but require updating
- 42 require no changes
- 35 are to be deleted
- To consider the **new** GNs that will be required for MHHS
- SGs to be implemented before M8 initial view that 11 are to be amended and 2 to be created

Next steps

GNs are used by customers – we may have our own view on priority however we want to test this with BSC Parties

- We propose publishing the list on the website for full visibility to customers
- Elexon to send out a MS Form to the BSC Change mailing list and via MHHSP's mailing list 'the Clock' seeking feedback on what GNs need to be updated for MHHS
