





### SDD and LLSD Feedback (2 of 2)

In addition to general feedback on formatting, style and points that required clarification, we also received some specific questions about:

- What the service hours will be for the Service Desk?
- How the Operator Portal will be accessed?
- What the Service Level Agreements (SLAs) will be for resolving issues?
- What the detailed steps are for the supporting processes (e.g. Incident, Change and Problem Management)

It's important to remember that the SDD and LLSD are initial documents and further details regarding the above points will be provided in the next document we produce:

### Service User Operating Manual – which is due in December (2024)

Optional sessions have also been booked in over the next few weeks, so you will have the opportunity to discuss any other specific points in relation to our responses

### Service Definition Document

To provide an overview of the support model in conjunction with the key industry standard ITIL processes that we will have in place to support the Market-Wide Half-Hourly Settlement system. This is an External Document for review

### Low Level Service Design

A comprehensive and detailed blueprint that translates the broader concepts and objectives outlined in the MHHS Service Strategy. This is an External Document for review

### Service Design Pack

A comprehensive information that consolidates all the necessary information, documentation, and guidelines defined in the Low-Level Service Design. This is an Internal document to collect operating information.

### Policy and Processes

Policies provide the strategic direction and rules that shape an our approach, while processes offer the practical steps needed to implement those policies effectively. This is internal documentation which underpins the Service Management offering.

### **Operating Manual**

Industry facing documents summarising the services being delivered

- The SDD and LLSD are Helix deliverables and therefore they sit outside of the MHHS Programme Governance framework
- We have carried out a consultation to ensure that Programme Participants have had the opportunity to provide feedback on the Service Design given the importance and relevance to them
- The MCAG and the SRO do not have the authority to approve these artefacts, but we are the MCAG to endorse these documents to show that
  - PPs are satisfied with the content that has been produced and
  - o your constituents are satisfied that their feedback has been taken into account through the consultation
- If the MCAG does not endorse these documents, Elexon we ask that you explain what concerns your constituents have raised in relation to these artefacts



## Updates from MWG

The Supplier Submission exercise was extremely well supported by Suppliers and has proven to be an invaluable exercise. The Migration team would like to thank all the suppliers that invested in this process

### Success 1 – Industry engagement

- Migration schedules were received for 99.72% of industry MPANs (i.e. 89,000 MPANs are not accounted for)
- 91% of the submissions adhered to the Migration Framework principles
- The MCC engagement and support processes worked (webinars, drop-in sessions, bi-laterals, support materials)

### Success 2 - Framework validity and integrity

- The Framework logic and calculations operated as intended
- Central system and LDSO thresholds were adhered to
- Migration capacity was allocated fairly
- There is sufficient contingency to protect M15

### **Success 3 - New insights and learnings**

- This exercise has enabled the MCC and participants to obtain early insights into opportunities and risks to the MHHS Migration
- Initial findings were discussed at the MWG on 10 October
- The MCC will publish a report by the end of October, documenting the insights, successes, opportunities and risks identified during this exercise and proposed next steps per finding

- 1. Reporting formats & templates, connection patterns with participants
- 2. Framework changes based upon learnings from submission round
- 3. Framework changes that may be required on currently tabled matters, e.g. Bulk Change of Agent Process




- The EES Full MPAN Refresh is due to take place across October and November, with each LDSO assigned a weekend slot to carry out the activity along with C&C
- Initial discussions were held during the previous DCWG meeting regarding further potential data cleanse activities that may be required. Participants have been asked to share their views on other activities that may be required ahead of the next DCWG to inform our next discussion:
  - Based on the recent population activities that have been carried out, a higher-than-expected number of exceptions have been raised, so we want to understand whether participants feel this requires further remedial work
- Any updates to the Data Cleanse Plan would require an industry consultation and approval by the MCAG


- With a view to current Programme participant priorities, and as part of an ongoing review of the artefacts currently being developed through the TORWG, the MHHS Programme has taken the decision to delay the MHHS Early Life Support Model (ELSM) industry consultation until November 2024. This will allow for more assurance of the proposed model before the industry consultation takes place. The Programme provided an update on this approach at TORWG on Wednesday 9 October 2024
- Work on the M16 Success Criteria has been paused, to allow the Programme to consider the impact of CR055 on the Transition Design. Once this has been considered, this piece of work will be re-visited
- The Elexon Helix team will continue to present regular updates to the TORWG on the progress of their Service Design






