Headline Report and Actions	DECISION: Headline Report of CCAG meeting held 22 January 2025 approved (CCAG-DEC65 – recording timestamp 00:04:40).
•	 DECISION: Headline Report of CCAG meeting heid 22 saturary 2023 approved (CCAG-DEC65 – recording timestamp 00:04:40). The DCUSA Representative provided an update on DCP440 and confirmed it has been to sent to the Authority for approval. They noted there is a minor impact on the Programme however, there is no Code impact, so it aligns with DCUSA's BAU process. The REC Code Manager provided an update on the REC changes: The MHHS Code Lead asked when the implementation date R0201 would be. The REC Code Manager explained it was unconfirmed as it's still in the early stages and the BSC change hasn't been raised yet, although current planning is to work towards February 2026. The MHHS Code Lead queried if there is going to be an update under from the Elexon Representative on this during their section. The Elexon Representative confirmed this change hasn't been raised yet, however, they are holding the first MHHS Expert Group on 6th March 2025 where they'll take all MHHS impacting changes that they've got on the backlog to present there before raising. The Elexon Representative provided a verbal update on the BSC changes. They confirmed there weren't any changes raised this month as they have been focused on setting up the MHHS Expert group as previously mentioned, which they plan to hold regularly over the next coming months. The Chair queried if anyone from the Programme will be attending the MHHS Expert Group. The Elexon Representative confirmed the MHHS Code Lead and, Senior Design and Industry Code Advisor have been invited. The Supplier Agent Representative queried what the SLAs are for sending the agenda ahead of the meeting so they can assess who from the rise is place to attend. The Elexon Representative confirmed they send to attendees off the back of CCAG.
	 ACTION – The Elexon Representative to send the MHHS Expert Group agenda following CCAG (CCAG39-01). The REC Code Manager highlighted that the MHHS Expert Group is on the same day as REC Change Issue Group so asked if the overlap of timings could be kept to a minimum. The DIP Manager provided a verbal update on the DIP changes. They explained they are conducting and internal review and will update the Horizon Scanning log by the end of the week, noting they have two changes coming up. The first one is change following CR054 and the second is around adding more clarity into the Code on Dip Onboarding and how different criteria will be assessed. The MHHS Code Lead queried if there is an update on the change related to Non-functional requirements. The Dip Manager confirmed this has been approved and will be implemented tomorrow. The REC Representative queried if one of their upcoming changes includes the mentioned further update to the CoCo. The Dip Manager confirmed they haven't seen the newest proposal yet but it's on their backlog as a potential change.

Reporting Milestones, CCAG Risks	The National Grid ESO Representative provided a verbal update and confirmed that CMP430 goes live on 1 st April 2025. They highlighted that there's a version of the legal text that is in a holding pattern, waiting to be released with the rest of the charging changes for 2025 and into 2026, however, there is no impact expected to the Programme. The Programme provided an update on the milestone status, risks and Post M6/pre M8 Code Change Approach and Planning. They highlighted that it is being proposed to bring M8 forward by 2 days to 22 September 2025 which will require a formal change request and approval by CCAG. The REC Representative noted that the risk description of R1052 only calls out the REC Change Issue Group however, there may be other groups that are also requesting the expansion of M8 drafting. The Programme confirmed they are happy to reword this risk to reference all code related work groups. • ACTION – The Programme to update the risk description of R1052 to reference all code related work groups (CCAG39-02).
and Post-M6 Change	The Programme provided an update on the M8 Change Control log and presented a high-level breakdown of the change records. They highlighted that the majority of the changes recorded are BSC own and therefore requested the Elexon Representative and another member of his team to validate those changes in the log. They added that they are going to publish an updated version of the log on the Collaboration Base as well as the REC website. They also provided an update on M8 Code change proposed timelines in order to approve changes before M8. They highlighted that CDWG will be stood up in June to endorse the changes which will then be taken to CCAG at end of June for approval.
M8 Code Implementation	The Code Bodies provided an update on M8 Code Implementation/go-live. No comments or queries were raised from CCAG.
Summary and Next Steps	ACTION – Programme to cancel March CDWG1 (CCAG39-03). The BSC Representative added they are continuing to update the Guidance Notes and will be releasing a few more this month in their Newscast.
