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# **Key Discussion Items**

Area	Discussion
	The Programme presented the proposed SITOPS Scope Modifications, SITOPS-BR04 and SITOPS-BR05, which were recommended by SITWG to SITAG to retrospectively descope as they were previously agreed during the SITOPS testing phase (March 2025).
SIT Scope Modification Proposal	Ofgem queried if evidence has been captured that the tests proposed to be descoped will not negatively impact the Programme in the future. The Programme confirmed that this activity went through formal PIT assurance and was successfully tested in PIT.
	<b>DECISION:</b> The Chair, acting with delegated authority of the MHHS Senior Responsible Owner (SRO), approved the July 2025 SIT Scope Modification document (SITAG-DEC79 – recording timestamp 00:07:02).
	The Programme summarised the industry feedback received on the SIT Functional & Migration SI Overarching Exit Report and outlined the updates that have been made following the addendum for the completion of SIT-A Settlement, Regression, and SAT Settlement Regression.
SIT Functional & Migration SI Overarching Exit Report	The Chair sought approval from SITAG of the SIT Functional & Migration SI Overarching Exit Report (T2-TE-0800 and T2-TE-0850). No questions or comments were received.
	<b>DECISION:</b> The Chair, acting with delegated authority of the MHHS Senior Responsible Owner (SRO), approved the SIT Functional & Migration SI Overarching Exit Report v1.0 (SITAG-DEC80 – recording timestamp 00:10:50).
	The Programme summarised the industry feedback received on the SIT Operational SI Overarching Exit Report and outlined the proposal to seek approval of v0.3 of the report, following minor feedback that will be uplifted to v1.0 and published on the Collaboration Base following SITAG approval.
SIT Operational SI Overarching Exit Report	The Chair sought approval from SITAG of the SIT Operational SI Overarching Exit Report (T2-TE-0950). No questions or comments were received. No questions or comments were received.
	<b>DECISION:</b> The Chair, acting with delegated authority of the MHHS Senior Responsible Owner (SRO), approved the SIT Operational SI Overarching Exit Report v1.0 (SITAG-DEC81 – recording timestamp 00:12:52).

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	Following the approval of all SIT Exit Reports and the delegation from PSG to provide SITAG with authority to seek approval of the T1 milestone,
	'T1-TE-2000 SIT Complete (SIT Test Exit Approved)', the Programme sought approval from SITAG.
SIT Completion	The REC Representative queried the progress of the separately approved SIT RTTMs to ensure there is transparency and traceability that all activities are complete in light of the T1 SIT Complete approval. The Programme confirmed the SIT Functional & Migration RTTM presented some challenges in terms of collating into one document and highlighted it has been agreed that the separately approved SIT RTTMs will be published into one area on the MHHS Collaboration Base by Tuesday 19 August 2025.
	<b>ACTION</b> – Programme to provide clear navigation to the separately approved SIT RTTMs on the MHHS Collaboration Base for Code Bodies by Tuesday 19 August 2025 ( <b>eSITAG18.1-01</b> ).
	<b>DECISION:</b> The Chair, acting with delegated authority of the MHHS Senior Responsible Owner (SRO), approved the SIT Completion T1 Milestone 'SIT Complete (SIT Test Exit Approved) (SITAG-DEC82 – recording timestamp 00:18:45).
	Following approval of the T1 milestone, 'T1-TE-2000 SIT Complete (SIT Test Exit Approved)', the Programme sought approval from SITAG to formally stand-down the SIT-B environment, as it is no longer required for any further testing activities.
SIT-B Environment Closure	The Small Supplier Representative highlighted that all audits are still in progress for testing completed in the SIT-B Environment and queried if there is a date for when those audits will complete. The Programme confirmed they are confident that all testing has completed in the SIT-B Environment, noting that the SIT-A Environment is still available for testing.
	<b>DECISION:</b> The Chair, acting with delegated authority of the MHHS Senior Responsible Owner (SRO), approved the decision to formally stand down the Programme's SIT-B Environment (SITAG-DEC83 – recording timestamp 00:21:55).
