Qualification Governance Update

Qualification is a key MHHSP workstream and as we progress into the next stage of the Programme post-M10, it is necessary that we review the Programme Governance around Qualification to ensure it provides appropriate engagement and oversight

1. Bring SAQTSG into QWG

Context

In September, LDSOs and SIT parties will be Qualified or nearing the end of Qualification and the remaining PPs will be those going through QT

Proposal

Therefore, it has been proposed to bring SAQTSG into QWG and have one forum to discuss Non-SIT S&A testing, Wave and QAD related updates and queries

Next Steps

The trial QWG meeting with SAQTSG content included was held on 3 September 2025 which was received well. QAG are now requested to approve the permanent merge of SAQTSG into QWG

2. Change to QAG schedule

Context

Given the stage of the Programme, it is anticipated that fewer decisions will be required to be made by QAG as Qualification becomes more operationalised and moves into BAU

Proposal

It is proposed that QAG will remain in diaries but reviewed monthly for decisions around planned milestones and any changes to baselined artefacts that require a meeting, as well as a request from QAG representatives

Next Steps

From October onwards, the need for QAG will be reviewed monthly, and cancelled if not deemed necessary, which will be communicated out to QAG members, with a minimum of 5 working days notice
