
Wave 1 and 2 QT Progress




- PP10 passed 3 tests last week. Execution velocity impacted by internal defect, which is blocking 8 tests with no ETA. Forecasting they are unlikely to complete the required 5 tests to bring them back on plan in current sprint cycle but should return to green in next sprint cycle.
- PP11 saw a couple of passed test last week and have multiple QTCs in progress, but internal defect continues to block 6 tests. Fix expected mid-week. If current in progress tests success this week, would see a return to the planned forecast by the end of the current sprint cycle and a return to Green.



Wave 3 and Wave 4 Planning


Qualification testing team resource modelling is needed to ensure that planned testing for QT Waves 3 and 4 are adequately supported. Sandbox testing support is to be included in resource modelling – dependency on understanding requirements via PPIR responses. Resource modelling is to conclude by 21/11/2025.

- Clarification of Wave 3 participants' Reliance position and minimum viable test set volumes is in progress. MTS test plans will be baselined with Participants by 10th November. The Wave 3 plan-on-a-page view of key activities and milestones is shown on the next slide.
- Early engagement meetings with Wave 3 participants will be scheduled from 10th November with focus on sharing best practice and useful QT readiness collateral to support participant preparation.
- The interim view of Wave 4 Reliance position, along with any known participant exemptions/exclusions as at 14th November will be used for assumptions-based Wave 4 resource modelling. The Wave 4 plan-on-a-page view of key activities and milestones will be shared via QTEF and QWG. We expect to lock down detailed MTS plans with Wave 4 participants early January.



PPIR for Sandbox

The Elexon Non-SIT Qualification Test team issued a Post-Qualification Testing (QT) Sandbox Programme Participant Information Request (PPIR) on 30 October for all Non-SIT Suppliers and Agents to complete by 14 November.

The purpose of the PPIR is to support the Non-SIT Qualification Test team to assess the scope and design of the Non-SIT Supplier and Agent Sandbox Testing tools. The Non-SIT Supplier and Agent Sandbox is provided for participants to conduct any testing beyond the minimum test set required for Qualification, in a defined period post Non-SIT QT completion through to the current planned end date of 28 August 2026.

Headline PPIR Response Summary:

- 33 participant responses to the PPIR
- > 19 participants are planning to use the Sandbox test environment beyond minimum test set:
 - 5 from Wave 1, ramping down to June
 - 6 from Wave 2, ramping down to June and two to August end date
 - 7 from Wave 3, ramping down to August end date
 - 1 from Wave 4 until the August end date
- > 14 participants from Waves 1, 3 & 4 are not intending to use the Sandbox test environment beyond minimum test set.
- > Environment use is being factored into the future Non-SIT Qualification Test team resourcing and tooling plans for 2026.



Qualification Programme Plan Update

- The Programme and Code Bodies have collaborated to update the Qualification Wave plan, so it aligns
 more closely with the approach being taken to track the progress of the Qualification Waves.
- The proposed updated plan has not resulted in any date changes.
- The as-is plan has milestones which are only met if all PPs in a Wave meet the dates. This has caused an
 issue with reporting at QWG and QAG, where Code Bodies have asked that the milestones relating to the
 start of Qualification Testing Execution to be approved, despite the fact some PPs in a Wave have not
 completed their Test Preparation activities.
- The focus of the updates has been to redefine some milestones, so they provide a more accurate and nuanced measure of how preparations towards commencing Qualification Testing Execution is going and how the Wave is progressing.
- Please note that we are only proposing to amend the plan for Waves 1, 2 and 3, the Wave 4 plan will remain as-is.
- QWG recommended that the proposed updates to the plan were taken to QAG for formal approval.



Qualification Plan Proposed Amendments – Wave 1 - 3

We propose that the Qualification plan is amended so the milestones in Waves 1, 2 and 3 are more aligned to Code Bodies reporting. Our proposal is detailed below.

Redefine these milestones so they're met once the threshold of PPs required to start Wave QT execution have completed them, instead of being met once all PPs in the Wave complete them, as currently defined. This avoids the current situation where these QT preparatory milestones are overdue / red in the plan because as little as one PP has failed to achieve them, even though QT execution has commenced, which is a contradictory message to bring to QWG and QAG.

To ensure the programme plan is still providing visibility of the progress all PPs in the Wave make against these preparatory activities, we propose to create new activities, with the same titles, which are met once all PPs in the Wave complete them. These new activities will not have milestone IDs, so won't explicitly be reported on, but the progress of all PPs through the wave will be reported on and presented to QWG / QAG regularly.




Qualification Plan Proposed Amendments – Wave 1 - 3

Redefine T3-QU-0027 so it refers to the minimum threshold of PPs in the Wave who are required to be ready for QT Start. This allows us to avoid the situation where we are asking to start QT, despite not all PPs being ready. All PPs readiness will continue to be monitored by creating a new activity with refers to all PPs in the Wave.

Redefine T3-QU-0105 so it refers 80% of 'M14 Critical' PPs in the Wave completing the activity, rather than all. 'M14 Critical' refers to those PPs who need to be qualified by M14, noting that there are some new entrant PPs in the Waves who are not required to hit M14.

Create a new T3 milestone, which has the same date as T2-QU-0150 below and is met once 80% of 'M14 Critical' PPs in the Wave have qualified. This allows the plan to show a more nuanced picture of how the Waves are progressing. If we only have the T2 and even one PP doesn't qualify by the Wave 'end' date, then the Wave will be overdue in the plan, but it won't be clear whether this means one or all PPs in the Wave have failed to qualify in time.





Qualification Plan Proposed Amendments – Wave 4

We proposed that Wave 4 remains as-is, with each milestone only achieved once all PPs in the Wave have achieved them, because there is little contingency in Wave 4. Any M14 critical PPs who miss the milestones dates risk not qualifying in time by M14 and risking its achievement.
