



Qualification progress update – Closure of SIT Pathway 6



SIT Pathway 6

- Pathway 6 is the final pathway by which SIT participants qualify for MHHS and is due to close on 18/12/25
- Participants with a December Target PAB date in Pathway 6 are on track for Qualification.
- There are 2x participants who are unable to qualify by this date and have agreed target PAB dates with Code Bodies before 30th July 2026
- In response to this, Code Bodies propose to extend the end date for Pathway 6 from 18/12/25 to **30/07/26**. MHHS Programme Milestone Date for T3-QU-0086 "SIT Participants are Qualified" will be updated to this date
- The "SIT Party MHHS Qualification Steps" outlined in 9.1.2 of the QA&P are unchanged. It is not expected that this extension to Pathway 6 timelines impacts the delivery of M14 on time
- Extension of the established 'Pathway' approach to Qualification has been assessed as the least impactful option to participants,
 Programme governance and Qualification requirements
- This was discussed at QWG at its 9 December meeting and no objections were raised



Sandbox Guidance

- Following the recent PPIR, Sandbox will now be made available to participants once they have passed their Qualification Tests
- MHHS-DEL2736 E2E Sandbox Guidance and MHHS-DEL1118 Qualification Approach and Plan together describe what the Sandbox is for and how it should be used by participants

Sandbox overview:

- Sandbox testing can only start following successful completion of Qualification Testing in the QT environment
- Sandbox is intended to further reduce the risk to live service
- Following participant completion of Qualification Testing and submission of Test Exit Reports, Participants are reminded of the QAD Director's declaration which states:
 - "The processes and controls noted within this Qualification Assessment Document are an accurate reflection for our arrangements for MHHS live operations, and I acknowledge that any further changes will be required to be disclosed to BSC and REC as detailed in 7.3.7 of the Qualification Approach and Plan".
- Examples that may trigger such disclosures include (but aren't limited to) material changes between participant systems tested in QT and those used during sandbox testing
- Following Qualification Testing, Code Bodies may check in with participants to assure their QAD declaration remains accurate:
 - We will provide further detail on what this entails for the Qualification Approval process at future QWG meetings



Sandbox Approach & Plan

Sandbox PPIR

Completed

- 44 participant responses to the PPIR.
- 23 (52%) participants are planning to use Sandbox Environment (5 from Wave 1, 6 from Wave 2, 7 from Wave 3, 5 from Wave 4).
- 21 (48%) participants not intending to use Sandbox Environment.

- Sandbox Proforma must be completed by each participant planning to use the Sandbox Environment.
- It is recommended all participants read the updated DRAFT MHHS-DEL2736 - E2E Sandbox Guidance v2.4 [For review and endorsement at this QWG on 09/12 and sign off at QAG on 17/12].

Sandbox Test Execution

Participant by Participant Basis

- Each Programme participant will execute their chosen tests and report internally according to their own processes for preparation, execution progress and completion.
- The Programme is not expected to monitor each Programme participant's test execution activities or centrally report on this activity.
- The defect management process for Sandbox will align with that defined for Qualification Testing and SIT (for early Sandbox testing).

Sandbox Env. Closure

28 August 2026

- Each Programme participant shall be responsible for conducting their own assurance activities for all testing executed.
- As Sandbox testing is an optional test phase, there are no formal programme exit criteria / conditions set for Programme participants.
- The E2E Sandbox test environment is a time limited facility. On 28 August 26, access to the Sandbox environment will be removed for use by Participants.



Sandbox Guidelines document – v2.4 Decision

Decision

- Sandbox Guidance has been updated to v2.4 with principles previously socialised via QTEF. Updates to the document are minor:
 - 1. Figure 2 timeline updated in section 5
 - 2. Inclusion of section 9.3.1 "Entry Criteria for Supplier and Agent Sandbox Testing"
 - 3. Additional bullet within section 9.11 Defect Management confirming QT defect resolution priority vs. Sandbox defects
- We are seeking QAG approval to approve this updated document.
- The document will then be published via Programme Channels (red lined and clean version) via the Programme Portal



Qualification progress update – New entrants update

Closure of transitional arrangements (i.e. MHHS Programme QT Waves) to new market entrants for MHHS:

- Code Bodies have been supporting c.11 new market entrants to Qualify in MHHS via the Transitional Arrangements
- Effective from QWG (9th December), the qualification transitional arrangements closed for any additional new market entrants as the dates for Wave 4 entry have now passed. New entrants that have already started a PQS can continue with their qualification application under transitional arrangements

- M14 is the MHHS Programme Milestone where "All suppliers must be able to access MPANs under the new TOM"
- This includes suppliers which have qualified in legacy market after M10

Sanctions at M14 do not apply to half hourly market new entrants in the process of qualifying via enduring arrangements





Qualification Testing for Non-SIT S&A Wave 3 Test Readiness

The Code Bodies recommend that QAG advise the SRO to approve **T3-QU-0102** (Minimum threshold of Qualification Wave 3 Participants required for QT start have submitted their initial QAD) on the basis that all participants are forecasted to start QT on 12 January 2026, 93% have submitted their Initial QAD, and any outstanding items are expected to be rectified before or shortly after the Wave start.

The Code Bodies recommend that QAG advise the SRO to approve **T3-QU-0025** (Confirmation from Qualification Wave 3 Participants that DIP Onboarding has commenced) on the basis that participants are forecasted to start QT on 12 January 2026 have started DIP onboarding.

The Code Bodies recommend that QAG advise the SRO to approve **T3-QU-0103** (Minimum threshold of Qualification Wave 3 Participants' required for QT start to provide status of PIT completion and submit QT Test Plan) based on 80% PIT completion 83% QT Test Plans agreed, and due to complete by 12 January 2026.

The Code Bodies recommend that QAG advise the SRO to approve **T3-QU-0024** (Minimum threshold of Qualification Test Plans for Wave 3 Participants required for QT start approved) based on 100% of test sets agreed and 83% QT Test Plans agreed, and due to complete by 12 January 2026..

The Code Bodies recommend that QAG advise the SRO to approve **T3-QU-0104** (Minimum threshold of Qualification Wave 3 Participants required for QT start have submitted PIT Test Completion Report and evidence for QT Entry) based on 80% PIT completion 83% QT Test Plans agreed, and due to complete by 12 January 2026.

The Code Bodies recommend that QAG advise the SRO to approve **T3-QU-0038** (Minimum threshold of Qualification Wave 3 Participant required for QT start Test Readiness confirmed) on the basis that in-progress smoke testing is forecast to complete by 12 January 2026.








