

2 Introduction

2.1 Purpose of the Document

This document sets out the Data Requirements for the Migration Control Centre (MCC) and the Migration Planning Management Tool (MPMT).

This document outlines the Data Requirements for the Migration Control Centre (MCC) and the Migration Planning Management Tool (MPMT), as well as providing a view of the external Migration Report Catalogue.

It seeks to ensure that the MCC and Industry Stakeholders have the necessary data and reporting capabilities to monitor, manage, and control the MHHS migration effectively.

2.2 Overview

2.2.1 Data Requirements

The Data Requirements section aims to:

- Identify key data sources and reports that will serve as inputs for the MCC and MPMT
- Ensure the accuracy and completeness of reference data used by the MCC and MPMT
- Understand additional data requirements to support the development of the MCC and MPMT

2.2.2 Reporting Catalogue

The Reporting Catalogue section seeks to:

- Specify the structure and classification for Migration reports
- Identify reports timings and high-level content, and purpose
- Provide an opportunity for stakeholders to offer feedback and opinions
- Support a MCC Principle of continuous monitoring and improvement of the migration process
- Present a core set of Migration Reports that can be iteratively enhanced during the active migration window

We acknowledge that additional Migration insights and requirements may emerge through consultation and operational experience

3 Objectives

The Migration Team aims to achieve the following objectives:

1. Identify Sources and Types of Data

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Determine the data sources and other information including other Party reports that the MCC will need to Monitor, Manage and Control the MHHS migration.

2. Clarify Key Reports

Provide an overview of essential reports that parties can expect from the MCC, with key data items and expected frequency

3. Avoid Reporting Duplication

Ensure that MCC reporting complements the MHHS Programme and does not result in duplication of effort or information where practical.

4. Develop and Confirm Reports

Once we establish the high-level report definitions, we will further refine the structure and data to assist parties in their planning and process development..

5. Feedback and Adaptation

Acknowledge that this list of reports is an important starting point and remains open to feedback to address additional requirements concerning data and frequency.

The Migration Team is committed to producing information that supports the Migration Framework principles and ensures clarity for all parties involved in the migration execution.

By collaborating with industry stakeholders, the team aims to create a reporting framework that meets the evolving needs of the MHHS migration processes.
